REMINDER TO RESPECT YOUR NEIGHBORS

With the arrival of warm weather upon us, we all want to leave our homes and enjoy the outdoors to work on our yards and celebrate with family and friends. In doing so, please respect your neighbors and follow the town noise ordinances which state no unreasonable audible noises within 25 feet from the source between the hours of 10 p.m.—7 a.m.

Unreasonable noises include: electrically amplified sound, non-licensed motor vehicle gasoline engines, non-vehicular gasoline engines and electric tools, repair or adjustment of motor vehicles and gatherings of persons engaged in loud and continuing activities continuing for a minimum of fifteen minutes between those key hours of 10 p.m.—7 a.m.
