Beware of FRAUD!

The Lochbuie Police Department has recently become aware of a fraud/scam that is taking place in our area. Officers were advised that the scheme offers an opportunity to become a “secret shopper”. A FedEx package will arrive containing a letter and a “cashier’s check”. The letter will state that there has been an online application for employment for a “survey job” with various retailers (Walmart, CVS, Walgreens, etc.) and will request that a text message be sent confirming the receipt of the “check”. The checks contained in these packages are FRAUDULENT. DO NOT attempt to deposit these counterfeit funds. The email associated with these letters is: cunsultantandoperations@gmail.com and will be from a “John Saddle, HR Manager”. People who commit fraud generally tend to prey on the elderly. If you have elderly family members, friends or neighbors, please pass on this important information.

Remember, if it seems too good to be true, it probably is!

WELD COUNTY ROAD 2

As you are aware, construction has begun on WCR 2. Two new TEMPORARY travel lanes are now in use. These will be removed once the road construction is complete. Please exercise extra caution when traveling through the area.
